## Review of Civil Service Pay Policy and System Task Force's Consultation Paper on Phase One Study

At the briefing on 25 April 2002, we emphasized that, given the complexity and far-reaching implications of the Review on the Civil Service Pay Policy and System, we will need a much longer consultation period in order to collate the views of our members. We will also need time to study PwC Consulting's interim report. No doubt you will appreciate that the consultation period also conflicts with this year's annual civil service pay adjustment exercise, in particular a possible pay cut of 4.75% which will require our full attention. In such circumstances, it is our strong view that the end of the consultation period should be extended for at least one to two months as from 25 May 2002.
